INVITATION TO SUBMIT REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATION TO IMPORT, EXPORT, SELL, SUPPLY, DISTRIBUTE, BLEND AND PRODUCE THE LUBRICANTS AND GREASES IN SRI LANKA

The lubricant market in Sri Lanka operates under controlled conditions based on providing high quality lubricants at fair prices to the consumers. At present, 26 parties selected through a formal process are operating in the lubricant market and the Government of Sri Lanka is inviting eligible parties to apply for qualification to carry out the following activities with the aim of further promoting appropriate competition for a market that provides high quality lubricants.

1. Lubricants and Greases

- i. To import, export, sell, supply, distribute, blend and produce the Lubricants and Greases in Sri Lanka or,
- ii. To import, export, sell, supply and distribute the Lubricants and Greases in Sri Lanka

2. Genuine Transmission Oil (CVT, ATF, Gear Oil) recommended by Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM)s

- i. To import, export, sell, supply and distribute the Genuine Transmission Oil Continuously Variable Transmission (CVT) Oil, Automatic Transmission Fluid (ATF), Gear Oil in Sri Lanka

3. Marine Lubricants and Greases

- i. To import, export, sell, supply and distribute the Marine Lubricants and Greases in Sri Lanka

All requests should be prepared as per the format given in the Request for Qualification (RFQ) document and submitted before 1400 hours on 06.04.2023 which can be done by registered post or courier or by handing over to the Procurement Division of the Ministry. This document can be obtained from the Public Notice in the website of the Ministry of Power and Energy, www.energymin.gov.lk. A meeting for clarification of matters in this regard will be held on 23.03.2023 at 10.00 a.m. at this Ministry.
